

On Wednesday, 15 Oct, 2025, Indian equity benchmarks closed higher on Wednesday, buoyed by broad-based buying across sectors. On Thursday, 16 Oct, 2025, Indian equity benchmarks ended higher with significant gains on Thursday, with all sectoral indices traded in the green. 

## NIFTY MARKET BREADTH (W) - POSITIVE








## **NEWS BULLETIN**

- **Infosys** has reported 13.89% rise in its net profit at Rs 7,759 crore for the quarter ended September 30, 2025 as compared to Rs 6,813 crore for the same quarter in the previous year.
- Eternal has reported 64.13% rise in its net profit at Rs 691 crore for the quarter ended September 30, 2025 as compared to Rs 421 crore for the same quarter in the previous year.
- Aeroflex Industries has secured a new order worth around Rs 7.8 crore under the existing global agreement focused on the development of advanced flow control components for high-performance thermal management systems.
- Sunteck Realty has reported a 34% year-on-year increase in pre-sales to Rs 702 crore for the September quarter of FY26 as compared to 524 crore in Q2FY25. In Q2FY26, its collections increased 24% to Rs 331 crore as compared to Rs 267 crore in Q2FY25.


